A. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:05 p.m.

B. REVIEW OF COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES

Committee members briefly reviewed the items identified during the brainstorming session at the May 23, 2014 meeting. In particular the Committee members discussed the unique needs of runaway youth and the need to enhance the current response to this population due to the correlation with sex trafficking.

The Committee also continued discussions regarding the need to engage law enforcement and prosecutors utilizing a top-down approach through the Arizona Prosecuting Attorneys' Advisory Council (APAAC), Arizona Chiefs of Police and Arizona Conference of Police and Sheriffs.

C. COMMITTEE TRAINING PLAN

The Committee reviewed and approved the use of a *Training Plan* that prioritizes working with State agencies to institutionalize training requirements on sex trafficking and making training resources available statewide. Staff will contact state agencies identified in the *Training Plan* to determine: current training requirements (new employee and continuing education requirements); and current trainings offered to employees on sex trafficking.

Staff will also work with Prevent Child Abuse Arizona to add sex trafficking to the Children's Justice Training Offerings available to law enforcement, child welfare and child advocates statewide free of cost.
