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EXECUTIVE ORDER

Executive Order 2020-58

**Ensuring the Availability of the COVID Vaccine without Financial Barriers**

**WHEREAS**, on January 31, 2020, Secretary Alex Azar of the United States Department of Health and Human Services (“HHS”) declared a public health emergency to address COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S.”) §§ 26-303 and 36-787, I, as Governor of the State of Arizona, issued a declaration of Public Health State of Emergency due to the necessity to prepare for, prevent, respond to, and mitigate the spread of COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2020, the President of the United States announced Operation Warp Speed to accelerate development, production, and distribution of safe and effective COVID-19 vaccines; and

**WHEREAS**, there are currently two COVID-19 vaccine candidates that have filed with the United States Food and Drug Administration (“FDA”) for an Emergency Use Authorization (“EUA”); and

**WHEREAS**, safe and effective COVID vaccines will dramatically reduce the spread of disease; and

**WHEREAS**, federal law requires that vaccines approved by the United States Preventive Services Task Force be covered by private insurance, group health, self insured group health and state regulated health insurance plans with no copayment; and

**WHEREAS**, there is an expectation that after a COVID-19 vaccine has been approved for use by the FDA, federal law will require coverage of the COVID-19 vaccine without a copay or coinsurance; and

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. § 36-787, provides authority to the Arizona Department of Health Services (“ADHS”) to “...Planning and executing public health emergency assessment, mitigation, preparedness response and recovery”... and to “collaborat[e] with...private organizations and private sector companies;” and

**WHEREAS**, absent the availability and use of a vaccine, the effects of COVID-19 will continue to strain Arizona’s health care systems and the everyday lives of Arizonans; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the public health that all Arizonans have access to COVID-19 vaccinations without financial barriers such as copays and coinsurance that may prolong and inhibit recovery from the COVID-19 emergency.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Douglas A. Ducey, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, including A.R.S. §§ 26-303 and 36-787 hereby order as follows:

1. ADHS, in conjunction with the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions, shall require that all insurers regulated by the State waive all cost-sharing requirements for consumers related to the administration of all COVID-19 vaccinations and without regard to whether the provider is in-network.
2. This Executive Order shall expire upon the termination of the Declaration of Public Health Emergency related to COVID-19 and dated March 11, 2020 or upon the effective date of a federal requirement that the COVID-19 be provided without cost-sharing.
